baklava old fashioned 15

redemption bourbon, cinnamon syrup, black walnut bitters, candied walnut

greca negroni 15

empress 1908 gin, roots diktamo, otto’s athens vermouth, orange

Empress 1908 gin has a natural blue color that comes from herbal infusions among the botanicals; it’s not juniper-forward but, rather, gentle and sophisticated, blending wonderfully with Roots Diktamo (an amaro-like herb liqueur from Greece) and Otto’s, a Greek vermouth with hints of rose petal

cloudy sunday 15

litchfield bourbon, roots kanela, roots diktamo, fresh-squeezed lime juice

The name of the drink is taken for the song "Sinnefiasmeni Kyriaki (Cloudy Sunday)" which was written during the brutal Nazi Occupation of Greece.

The song talks about the singer's wait for the clouds to pass, a reference to the occupation. The slight bitterness of the Diktamo represents the suffering of the Greeks at the time, with the sweetness of the Roots Kanela (a sophisticated cinnamon tincture) representing better times ahead. The lime gives it the cloud, and the bourbon represents the strong character of the people that helped them to survive the occupation.

the socratic method 14

litchfield bourbon, roots rakomelo, fresh sage

Sage (for wisdom) is gently muddled and mixed with locally-produced bourbon from Litchfield Distillery and Roots Rakomelo, a honey-infused Greek grappa (don’t let the word grappa fool you, this isn’t fire water, it’s an elegant, smooth spirit)

greca mule 13

tito’s handmade vodka, roots rakomelo, gosling ginger beer, fresh-squeezed lime juice, orange

the rebetiko 16

butterfly pea tea-infused barbayianni ouzo, plantation rum, chartreuse, simple syrup, fresh-squeezed lime juice

Named for the Greek blues (rebetiko), our ouzo infusion tints the beverage a beautiful blue hue that becomes a light purple when mixed with the other ingredients.

speak to me of god 15

stray dog gin, orgeat, fresh-squeezed lemon juice, pineapple juice, quince syrup, candied quince

Essence of almond (from the orgeat) gives this exotic beverage it’s soft character. Named for a quote by Greek novelist and philosopher Nikos Katzantzakis: “And I said to the almond tree, ‘Sister, speak to me of god’, and the almond tree blossomed”.

dirty greca ’tini 15

tito’s handmade vodka, caperberry with a splash of its brine

greca ’rita 15

illegal mezcal, italicus bergamont liqueur, pomegranate juice, lime juice

kiss the fig 12

figenza vodka, prosecco, blackberries

the wine-dark sea 16

tito’s handmade vodka, fresh lemon juice, simple syrup, mint, red wine float

This drink takes its name from a line from Homer’s Odyssey and is as enigmatic, alluring and dangerous as the sea

rakomelo & coke 12

roots rakomelo, coke, squeezed lime

the anthony quinn 14

patron xo coffee liqueur, greek iced coffee frappe

What do you name a drink that blends a spirit from Mexico with a coffee from Greece? Anthony Quinn was, of course, the Mexican-born actor who portrayed Greeks in several big Hollywood films, most famously as Zorba the Greek

circe’s spell 15 ***no-LO***

spicy ritual zero-alcohol tequila, effen blood orange vodka, lime juice, simple syrup

bluegrass mule * 13 ***NO-lo***

ritual zero-alcohol whisky, gosling’s ginger beer, lime juice

* all no-alcohol spirits contain have up to .05% alcohol, a natural result of the fermentation process

persephone’s dew 5

pomegranate juice, honey ginger syrup, fresh squeezed lemon juice, splash ginger ale

cinnamon spice soda 4

house made syrup with cinnamon sticks and allspice berries

honey ginger soda 5

house made syrup with fresh ginger root and thyme honey

fresh-squeezed lemonade 6

house made freshly-squeezed with homemade simple syrup

greca frappe 5

iced coffee whipped into a frappe with condensed milk

sketo—bitter; metrio—semi sweet; glyko—sweet; vari-glyko—very sweet
